Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The Colorado youth advisory council (advisory committee) is set to repeal September 1, 2023. The bill implements the department of regulatory agencies'

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 2-2-1307 as 3 follows: 4 2-2-1307. Repeal of part. This part 13 is repealed, effective 5 September 1, 2023. Prior to the repeal of this part 13, the council must be 6 reviewed as provided for in section 2-3-1203. 7 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 8 (14)(a)(VI) as follows: 9 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 10 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (14) (a) The following statutory 11 authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for 12 repeal on September 1, 2023: 13 (VI) The Colorado youth advisory council created in section 14 2-2-1302; 15 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 16 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 17 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 18 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 19 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 20 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 21 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 22 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 23 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
