### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION
102	DESIGNATION BENEFITING THE PUBLIC EDUCATION FUND TO
103	APPEAR ON THE STATE INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX RETURN FORMS,
104	AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION THEREFOR.

## **Bill Summary**

For income tax years commencing on or after January 1, 2011, but before January 1, 2021, the bill requires a voluntary contribution

SENATE 3rd Reading Unam ended M ay 2,2011 designation line for the public education fund (fund) to appear as the first voluntary contribution designation line on state individual income tax return forms.

The department of revenue must determine annually the total amount designated to the fund and report that amount to the state treasurer and the general assembly. The state treasurer shall credit that amount to the fund.

Finally, the general assembly must appropriate annually from the fund to the department of revenue its costs of administering contributions to the fund. All moneys remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall be appropriated to the department of education and the department of higher education as specified.

25	SHALL DETERMINE ANNUALLY THE TOTAL AMOUNT DESIGNATED

27	THE STATE TREASURER AND TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. THE STATE

2	thirty-three thousand two hundred fifty-six dollars (\$33,256) cash funds,
3	or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this
4	<u>act.</u>
5	(2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
6	appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and
7	budgeting, for allocation to the office of information technology, for the
8	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, the sum of twenty-nine thousand
9	six hundred dollars (\$29,600), or so much thereof as may be necessary,
10	for the provision of programming services to the department of revenue
11	related to the implementation of this act. Said sum shall be from
12	reappropriated funds received from the department of revenue out of the
13	appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section.
14	<b>SECTION</b> <u>3.</u> <b>Safety clause.</b> The general assembly hereby finds,
15	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
16	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
