SENATE BILL 23-140

BY SENATOR(S) Zenzinger and Kirkmeyer, Gonzales; also REPRESENTATIVE(S) Bird and Bockenfeld, Duran, Joseph, Lieder, Lynch, Snyder, Weinberg, McCluskie.

CONCERNING EXTENDING THE CONTRACT DEADLINE FOR THE INDEPENDENT STUDY OF HOUSE BILL 22-1326, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, EXTENDING A RELATED EXISTING APPROPRIATION.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-20.5-1501, **amend** (1)(a) as follows:

25-20.5-1501. Independent study - report - repeal. (1) (a) By January 1, 2023 OCTOBER 1, 2023, the department shall contract with an independent entity to conduct a study and publish a report concerning the impact and implementation of House Bill 22-1326.

SECTION 2. In Session Laws of Colorado 2022, section 56 of chapter 225 (HB 22-1326), **add** (13) as follows:

Section 56. Appropriation. (13) ANY MONEY APPROPRIATED IN

SUBSECTION (5)(f) OF THIS SECTION NOT EXPENDED PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2023, IS FURTHER APPROPRIATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT FOR USE BY THE PREVENTION SERVICES DIVISION FOR THE 2023-24 AND 2024-25 STATE FISCAL YEARS FOR THE SAME PURPOSE.

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
