2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 38-33.3-116, add (4)
3	as follows:
4	38-33.3-116. Exception for new small cooperatives and small
5	and limited expense planned communities. (4) NOTWITHSTANDING
6	ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A COOPERATIVE, PLANNED COMMUNITY,
7	OR OTHER ENTITY, HOWEVER DESIGNATED, THAT PURPORTS TO COME
8	WITHIN THE EXCEPTION STATED IN THIS SECTION SHALL NOT IMPOSE OR
9	FORECLOSE A LIEN FOR ASSESSMENTS OR FOR ANY OTHER FEE, CHARGE,
10	LATE CHARGE, ATTORNEY FEE, FINE, OR INTEREST ALLEGEDLY DUE TO THE
11	ENTITY UNLESS THE DECLARATION PROVIDES THAT THIS ENTIRE ARTICLE
12	IS APPLICABLE. A LIEN IMPOSED IN VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION (4),
13	REGARDLESS OF WHEN IT IS OR WAS IMPOSED, IS HEREBY DECLARED
14	CONTRARY TO PUBLIC POLICY AND IS VOID.
15	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
16	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
17	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
