1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

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Department of Law, Special Purpose, Litigation Management and Technology -- It is the intent of the General Assembly to grant the Department of Law additional flexibility by allowing the Department to use moneys appropriated in this line item to address unanticipated state legal needs that arise during FY 2014-15. It is also the intent of the General Assembly that moneys spent from this line item shall not require the appropriation of additional FTE and will not be used for any type of salary increase, promotion, reclassification, or bonus related to any present or future FTE employed by the Department of Law. It is furthermore the intent of the General Assembly that moneys spent from this line item will not be used to offset present or future personal services deficits in
