101 CONCERNING COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL

102 ASSEMBLY APPOINTED TO AND SERVING ON STATE ENTITIES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill establishes uniform payments of per diem and the reimbursement of expenses to current members of the general assembly who are appointed to serve on state entities created or authorized by statute on which members of the general assembly are statutorily required to be appointed to serve. When the general assembly is in session and legislative members attend meetings of a state entity to which they are appointed, legislative members will only receive the per diem lodging and expense allowances and travel expenses that they receive as legislative members. When the general assembly is not in session or is in recess for more than 3 days and legislative members attend meetings of a state entity to which they are appointed, legislative members will receive the same per diem and travel and subsistence expenses received by legislative members for necessary attendance at meetings or functions or to legislative matters during the legislative recess or interim.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 2-2-326 as 2 3 follows: 4 2-2-326. Compensation and expenses for members appointed 5 to and serving on state entities - definition. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING 6 ANY LAW TO THE CONTRARY: 7 (a) WHILE APPOINTED TO ANY STATE ENTITY AND SERVING ON ANY 8 STATE ENTITY DURING REGULAR AND SPECIAL SESSIONS OF THE GENERAL 9 ASSEMBLY, IN ADDITION TO THE BASE COMPENSATION SPECIFIED IN 10 SECTION 2-2-307 (1), CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ARE 11 ENTITLED TO RECEIVE ONLY THE PER DIEM LODGING AND EXPENSE 12 ALLOWANCES AND THE TRAVEL EXPENSES AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 13 2-2-317; AND 14 (b) WHILE APPOINTED TO AND SERVING ON ANY STATE ENTITY 15 WHEN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS IN RECESS FOR MORE THAN THREE DAYS 16 OR IS NOT IN SESSION, IN ADDITION TO THE BASE COMPENSATION SPECIFIED 17 IN SECTION 2-2-307 (1), CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY 18 ARE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE AMOUNT SPECIFIED IN SECTION 2-2-307(3)

- 20 REIMBURSEMENT FOR ALL ACTUAL AND NECESSARY TRAVEL AND

SUBSISTENCE EXPENSES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH ATTENDANCE AT
 MEETINGS OF THE STATE ENTITY. MILEAGE RATES SHALL NOT EXCEED
 THOSE AUTHORIZED FOR THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT. ALL
 COMPENSATION PAID AND REIMBURSEMENTS MADE PURSUANT TO THIS
 PARAGRAPH (b) SHALL BE PAID FROM APPROPRIATIONS MADE TO THE
 LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.

7 (2) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "STATE ENTITY" MEANS ANY 8 BOARD, COMMISSION, COMMITTEE, TASK FORCE, COUNCIL, WORKING 9 GROUP, REVIEW TEAM, OR OTHER ENTITY CREATED OR AUTHORIZED BY 10 STATUTE ON WHICH CURRENT MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ARE 11 STATUTORILY REQUIRED TO BE APPOINTED TO SERVE; EXCEPT THAT 12 "STATE ENTITY" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE COLORADO COMMISSION ON 13 UNIFORM STATE LAWS CREATED IN SECTION 2-3-601 (1) OR THE 14 EDUCATION COMMISSION OF THE STATES CREATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 15 24-60-1201, C.R.S.

24 section 24-21-104 (3) (b), C.R.S.

25 SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1503, amend (3)
26 as follows:

27 **2-3-1503.** Legislative emergency preparedness, response, and

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recovery committee - creation - membership - duties. (3) EXCEPT AS
OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SECTION 2-2-326, the members of the legislative
committee shall serve without compensation. but the senators and
representatives serving on the legislative committee shall be entitled to
reimbursement of expenses incurred in serving on the legislative
committee.

7 SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-8-505, amend (8)

(8) Members of 10 the board shall serve without compensation EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE 11 PROVIDED IN SECTION 2-2-326, C.R.S., AND except that they shall be 12 reimbursed for any actual and necessary expenses incurred in the 13 performance of their duties under this part 5, with mileage rates not to 14 exceed those authorized for the executive department.

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1 are not associated with any of the other members or interests. Except for 2 the legislative members, members of the board shall be appointed by the 3 governor, who shall take into account the extent to which the board 4 represents the geographic areas, population concentrations, and ethnic communities of this state. Appointments by the governor shall be for a 5 6 period of four years. The three members of the general assembly shall be appointed one each by the governor, the speaker of the house of 7 8 representatives, and the president of the senate. No more than two of said 9 legislative members may be from the same major political party, and, 10 except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection (1), each such 11 legislative member shall be appointed for a term of two years or for the 12 same term to which they were elected, whichever is less. Successors shall 13 be appointed in the same manner as the original members. Vacancies of 14 all other members shall be filled by appointment by the governor for 15 unexpired terms. In the case of a vacancy, the remaining members of the 16 board shall exercise all the powers and authority of the board until such 17 vacancy is filled. The board shall choose its own chairperson by majority 18 vote of the quorum present at a meeting called for the purpose of electing 19 a chairperson. The board shall meet not less than annually. EXCEPT AS 20 OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SECTION 2-2-326, C.R.S., members of the board 21 shall receive no compensation but shall be reimbursed for all actual and 22 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties, AND such 23 expenses shall be paid from the appropriations from the division of 24 securities cash fund created in section 11-51-707. A majority of the board 25 shall constitute a quorum to transact business and for the exercise of any 26 of the powers or authority conferred.

 24 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 25 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
