#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING AUTHORITY FOR TAXICABS TO PICK UP PASSENGERS
OUTSIDE THEIR ASSIGNED GEOGRAPHIC AREAS.

#### **Bill Summary**

The bill allows taxicabs operating in the city and county of Denver to pick up passengers at any point in the state of Colorado when the taxicab has dropped off passengers near that point.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 40-10-105 (2) (d) (I), Colorado Revised Statutes,
3	is amended to read:
4	40-10-105. Rules for issuance of certificates - standing to
5	<b>protest - judicial review.</b> (2) (d) (I) $\underline{(A)}$ The holder of a certificate of
6	public convenience and necessity that contains authority to operate as a
7	taxicab between points in the city and county of Denver shall also be
8	deemed to hold taxicab authority from points in the city and county of
9	Denver to all points in the state of Colorado.
10	(B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION TO THE
11	CONTRARY, THE HOLDER OF A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND
12	NECESSITY THAT CONTAINS AUTHORITY TO OPERATE AS A TAXICAB
13	BETWEEN POINTS <u>WITHIN THE STATE OF COLORADO</u> SHALL ALSO BE
14	DEEMED TO HOLD TAXICAB AUTHORITY TO PICK UP PASSENGERS FROM ANY
15	POINT IN THE STATE OF COLORADO AND TRANSPORT THE PASSENGERS
16	BACK TO THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER'S AUTHORIZED AREA WHEN THE
17	CERTIFICATE HOLDER HAS DROPPED OFF PASSENGERS IN CLOSE PROXIMITY
18	TO THAT POINT. $\underline{\text{THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (B) DO NOT}}$
19	APPLY WHEN A TAXICAB DROPS OFF A PASSENGER AT ANY AIRPORT IN THIS
20	<u>STATE.</u>
21	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
22	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
