A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT ADVISORY BOARD, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS CONTAINED IN THE 2018 SUNSET REPORT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The bill implements the recommendations of the department of regulatory

agencies' sunset review by continuing the concurrent enrollment advisory board indefinitely.

(8) (a) This section is repealed, effective 5 6 July 1, 2019. 7 (b) Prior to said repeal, the board shall be reviewed as provided 8 in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S. 9 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal (8)(a)(III) as follows: 10 11 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 12 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (8) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July 13 14 1, 2019: 15 (III) The concurrent enrollment advisory board created in section 16 22-35-107, C.R.S.; 17 **SECTION 3.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 18 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 19 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
