A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE ROLE OF CERTAIN SOUTHERN COLORADO
102 UNIVERSITY CAMPUSES.

Bill Summary

Currently, Colorado state university - Pueblo may offer selected master's-level graduate programs. The bill would allow the university to offer selected graduate programs.

The bill clarifies the role and mission of the Colorado Springs campus of the University of Colorado.
