## **Bill Summary**

The bill increases the number of points from 4 to 12 that accumulate on a person's driver's license as a result of a conviction for careless driving resulting in death.

3	amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:
4	42-2-127. Authority to suspend license - to deny license - type
5	of conviction - points. (5) Point system schedule:
6	Type of conviction Points
7	(e.5) Careless driving resulting in death $\ldots \ldots 12$
8	SECTION 2. Specified effective date - applicability. This act
9	shall take effect upon passage and shall apply to offenses committed on
10	or after said date.
11	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
12	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
13	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
