102 VETERANS AFFAIRS.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - Senate State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee. The bill implements the recommendations of the sunset review and report on the Colorado board of veterans affairs by eliminating the repeal date of the board and extending the board indefinitely.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 28-5-702, **repeal** (6)
3 as follows:

4 **28-5-702. Board of veterans affairs - sunset review - repeal.**

5 (6) (a) ~~This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2017.~~

6 (b) ~~Prior to said repeal, the board shall be reviewed as provided~~
7 ~~for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.~~

8 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**

9 (4)(a)(I) as follows:

10 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**

11 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (4) (a) The following statutory

12 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July

13 1, 2017:

16 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
