CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE COLORADO BOARD OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 28-5-702, **repeal** (6) as follows:

28-5-702. Board of veterans affairs - sunset review - repeal.
(6) (a) ~~This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2017.~~

~~(b) Prior to said repeal, the board shall be reviewed as provided for in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S.~~

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal** (4)(a)(I) as follows:

Capital letters indicate new material added to existing statutes; dashes through words indicate deletions from existing statutes and such material not part of act.

2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative declaration - definition - repeal. (4) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July 1, 2017:

(I) ~~The Colorado board of veterans affairs created pursuant to section 28-5-702, C.R.S.;~~

SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,

determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
