CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN THE GENERAL FUND RESERVE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-201.1, **amend** (1)(d)(XXI) and (1)(d)(XXII); and **add** (1)(d)(XXIII) as follows:

24-75-201.1. Restriction on state appropriations - legislative declaration - definitions - repeal. (1) (d) For each fiscal year, unrestricted general fund year-end balances must be retained as a reserve in the following amounts:

(XXI) For the fiscal years 2020-21 and 2021-22, YEAR 2020-21, two

and eighty-six one-hundredths percent of the amount appropriated for expenditure from the general fund for that fiscal year; and

(XXII) For the fiscal year 2022-23 and each fiscal year thereafter, seven and twenty-five one-hundredths YEAR 2021-22, THIRTEEN AND FOUR-TENTHS percent of the amount appropriated for expenditure from the general fund for that fiscal year; AND

(XXIII) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, FIFTEEN PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED FOR EXPENDITURE FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THAT FISCAL YEAR.
