A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING EXTENDING THE REPEAL DATE OF THE COLORADO 102 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION.

Bill Summary

The bill extends the Colorado economic development commission by changing the repeal date of its organic statute to July 1, 2025.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 24-46-106 as
2	follows:
3	24-46-106. Repeal of part. This part 1 is repealed, effective July
4	1, 2017 July 1, 2025.
5	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
5	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
7	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
