1 WHEREAS, National Speech and Debate Education Day is
2 celebrated on March 2, 2018; and

3 WHEREAS, Established by the National Speech and Debate
4 Association, in conjunction with national and local partners, this event
5 serves to promote better instruction in speech and debate across all grade
6 levels and to highlight the pivotal roles these abilities play in personal
7 advocacy, social movements, and public policy making; and

9 important skills in communication, critical thinking, creativity, and
