101 **CONCERNING RECOGNITION OF MILITARY PERSONNEL FROM**
102 **COLORADO WHO HAVE SERVED AROUND THE WORLD IN THE**
103 **ONGOING WAR AGAINST TERRORISM AND HONORING THOSE WHO**
104 **HAVE DIED WHILE SERVING THE CAUSE OF FREEDOM.**

1 WHEREAS, Thousands of military personnel from Colorado have
2 served around the world in the ongoing war against terrorism, including
3 troops based at Fort Carson, the United States Air Force Academy,
4 Peterson Air Force Base, and Buckley Air Force Base; members of the
5 Colorado National Guard, Army Reserve, and Marine Corps Reserve; and
6 troops from Colorado who are deployed with military units based in other
7 states; and

8 WHEREAS, On March 22, 2019, Sgt. 1st Class Will D. Lindsay,

21 2nd Battalion, 10th Special Forces Group (Airborne), based at Fort
22 Carson, Colorado, made the ultimate sacrifice while serving his country
23 in Operation Freedom's Sentinel; and

24 WHEREAS, On August 11, 2019, Gunnery Sgt. Scott A.
25 Koppenhafer, of Mancos, Colorado, a member of the United States
26 Marine Corps assigned to 2nd Marine Raider Battalion, Marine Forces
27 Special Operations Command, based at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina,
