## "AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE OPERATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER PROTECTION."

Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2024*) (a) As used in this section:

4 (1) "Participant" means any person who is engaged in any 5 agritourism activity as a guest, patron, invitee or visitor at an 6 agritourism operator's facility;

7 (2) "Agritourism activity" (A) means any activity which allows any 8 participant to, for recreational, entertainment or educational purposes 9 and regardless of whether such activity is provided in exchange for a 10 fee or free of charge, view, participate in or enjoy any rural activity, 11 including, but not limited to, (i) any farming activity, (ii) any ranching 12 activity, (iii) any historic, cultural or natural attraction, (iv) any 13 educational program, (v) any hospitality service, (vi) any guided or selfguided tour, (vii) any bed and breakfast accommodation, (viii) any petting zoo, (ix) any farm festival, (x) any corn maze, (xi) any harvestyour-own operation, (xii) any hayride, (xiii) any barn party, (xiv) any horseback ride, or (xv) any fee fishing, and (B) does not include any activity in which the participant is paid to participate;

(3) "Agritourism operator" means any person who is engaged in the
business of providing, whether for profit or not for profit, any
agritourism activity; and

22 (4) "Risks inherent in agritourism activities" (A) means those dangers 23 or conditions that are an integral part of any agritourism activity, 24 including, but not limited to, (i) hazardous conditions such as surface 25 and subsurface conditions, (ii) natural conditions of any land, 26 vegetation or waters, (iii) the behavior of wild or domestic animals, and 27 (iv) ordinary dangers of structures or equipment ordinarily used in 28 farming or ranching operations, and (B) includes the potential that a 29 participant may act in a negligent manner that may contribute to the 30 participant's injury or the injury of any other person by, among other 31 things, (i) failing to follow any instructions given by the agritourism 32 operator or the agritourism operator's agents, employees or officers, or 33 (ii) failing to exercise reasonable caution while engaging in the 34 agritourism activity.

(b) (1) Except as provided in subdivision (2) of this subsection, each
participant shall assume the risk for any injury to such participant's
person arising out of the risks inherent in agritourism activities.

38 (2) The provisions of subdivision (1) of this subsection shall not be 39 construed to affect the right of any person to maintain any action against 40 an agritourism operator, or to limit the liability of an agritourism 41 operator, who, in offering and operating any agritourism activity (A) 42 commits any act or omission that constitutes negligence, (B) 43 intentionally causes the injury of another person, (C) acts with disregard 44 for the safety of the person injured, (D) fails to use a degree of care that 45 an ordinarily careful prudent person would use under similar

46 circumstances, or (E) fails to conspicuously post warning signs 47 disclosing the existence of a condition that is known to be dangerous in 48 the context of the agritourism activity. 49 (c) A written contract entered into by an agritourism operator and a participant, or an agent, employee or officer of an agritourism operator 50 51 and a participant, shall contain, in clearly readable print, a warning 52 notice stating that each participant shall assume the risk for any injury 53 to their person arising out of the risks inherent in agritourism activities."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
