"AN ACT CONCERNING IMMUNIZATIONS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) On or before October 1, 2021,
4 the Department of Public Health shall establish an adverse event
5 reporting system for restrictions or requirements implemented in
6 response to the COVID-19 pandemic, including, but not limited to, mask
7 requirements, business shutdowns, COVID-19 vaccines and any
8 government enforcement of such restrictions or requirements. The
9 department shall establish a process by which individuals or businesses
10 may submit adverse events to such system. On or before January 1, 2022,
11 and annually thereafter, the Commissioner of Public Health shall report,
12 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
13 to the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having
14 cognizance of matters relating to public health and commerce regarding

15 adverse events submitted to such system.

16 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) On and after September 1,
 17 2022, any child or student who (1) presented, prior to September 1, 2022,
 18 a statement that the immunizations required by section 10-204a, 10a-
 19 155, 10a-155b, 19a-79 or 19a-87b of the general statutes, as amended by
 20 this act, would be contrary to the religious beliefs of such child or
 21 student or the guardian of such child or student, and (2) suffers an injury
 22 or death as a result of receiving a vaccine that such child or student
 23 received to avoid unenrollment in a public or nonpublic school,
 24 institution of higher education, public or private college, child care
 25 center, group child care home or family child care home may file a claim
 26 against the state in accordance with the provisions of chapter 53 of the
 27 general statutes."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
