"AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE JUSTICE."

- 1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
- 2 following in lieu thereof:
- 3 "Section 1. Section 53a-212 of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):
- 5 (a) A person is guilty of stealing a firearm when, with intent to
- 6 deprive another person of such other person's firearm or to appropriate
- 7 the firearm to such person or a third party, such person wrongfully
- 8 takes, obtains or withholds a firearm, as defined in subdivision (19) of
- 9 section 53a-3.
- 10 (b) Stealing a firearm is a class [C] \underline{B} felony for which two years of the
- sentence imposed may not be suspended or reduced by the court, and
- 12 five thousand dollars of the fine imposed may not be remitted or
- 13 reduced by the court unless the court states on the record its reasons for

14 remitting or reducing such fine."
