AN ACT CONCERNING SCHOOL LUNCH DEBT.

SUMMARY

This bill requires local or regional boards of education, starting in the 2021-2022 school year, to include the following in any policies or

procedures for collecting unpaid school meal charges:

a prohibition on publicly identifying or shaming a child for any

unpaid meal charges, including (a) delaying or refusing to serve a meal to the child, (b) designating a specific meal for the child,

or (c) taking any disciplinary action against the child;

a declaration of a child's right to purchase one meal (which may

exclude a la carte items) for any school breakfast, lunch, or other

feeding; and

a procedure for communicating with parents or guardians

about collecting a child's unpaid meal charges, including giving

them (a) information on local food pantries, (b) applications for

free or reduced priced meals and the Department of Social Services' supplemental nutrition assistance program, and (c) a

link to the school district's website that lists any community

services available to town residents.

The bill also allows local or regional boards of education to accept

gifts, donations, or grants from any public or private source to pay off

any unpaid meal charges.
