AN ACT CONCERNING MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT FOR LEGISLATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 2-15 of the general statutes be amended to restrict the
- 2 transportation allowance to members or members-elect of the General
- 3 Assembly who drive a motor vehicle from their home to the State
- 4 Capitol or other location where a public hearing or meeting is held and
- 5 to prohibit any such member or member-elect who is a passenger in a
- 6 motor vehicle from collecting such allowance.

Statement of Purpose:

To restrict mileage reimbursement to legislators who drive to work and prohibit legislators who are passengers from collecting the reimbursement.
