**AN ACT ESTABLISHING QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE  
COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-3a of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 any person who is appointed Commissioner of Education to be a
- 3 qualified person with a master's degree or higher in an education-
- 4 related field, five or more years' experience as a teacher in this state or
- 5 another state and three or more years' experience as an administrator
- 6 of a school or school district in this state or another state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish qualifications for the position of Commissioner of Education.
