AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PERSONAL INCOME TAX DEDUCTION FOR STIPENDS PAID TO CERTAIN VOLUNTEER EMERGENCY PERSONNEL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-701 of the general statutes be amended to establish a
- 2 personal income tax deduction, not exceeding two thousand dollars, for
- 3 any stipend paid to a volunteer firefighter, volunteer fire police officer
- 4 or volunteer ambulance member by a municipality, volunteer fire
- 5 department or volunteer ambulance association.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a personal income tax deduction, not exceeding two thousand dollars, for any stipend paid to certain volunteer emergency personnel by a municipality, volunteer fire department or volunteer ambulance association.
