AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR TOBACCO CONTROL, PREVENTION AND CESSATION EFFORTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of twelve million dollars be appropriated to the
- 2 Department of Public Health, from the Tobacco Settlement Fund, for the
- 3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, and annually thereafter, to provide
- 4 funding for tobacco control, prevention and cessation programs and
- 5 services in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and
- 6 Prevention's best practices, as amended from time to time.

Statement of Purpose:

To annually provide twelve million dollars to tobacco control, prevention and cessation efforts in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's best practices.
