AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYMENT OF LAWFUL PERMANENT RESIDENTS AS POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 104 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit law
- 2 enforcement units and fire departments from requiring United States
- 3 citizenship as a condition of employment as a police officer or
- 4 firefighter, and to permit individuals who are classified as lawful
- 5 permanent residents of the United States under federal law to be
- 6 employed as such officers and firefighters.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit individuals who are classified as lawful permanent residents of the United States under federal law to be employed as police officers and firefighters.
