AN ACT CONCERNING THE PURCHASE OF BODY ARMOR BY FIREFIGHTERS, FIRE DEPARTMENTS, EMERGENCY SERVICES PERSONNEL AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 53-341b of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective
- October 1, 2019): 3
- 4 (b) The provisions of subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to
- 5 the sale or delivery of body armor to (1) a sworn member or
- 6 authorized official of an organized local police department, the
- 7 Division of State Police within the Department of Emergency Services
- 8 and Public Protection, the Division of Criminal Justice, the Department
- 9 of Correction, the Board of Pardons and Paroles or the Department of
- 10 Motor Vehicles, (2) an authorized official of a municipality or the
- 11 Department of Administrative Services that purchases body armor on
- 12 behalf of an organized local police department, the Division of State
- 13 Police within the Department of Emergency Services and Public
- 14 Protection, the Division of Criminal Justice, the Department of

15 Correction, the Board of Pardons and Paroles or the Department of 16 Motor Vehicles, (3) an authorized official of the Judicial Branch who 17 purchases body armor on behalf of a probation officer or a judicial 18 marshal, [or] (4) a member of the National Guard or the armed forces 19 reserve, (5) a firefighter or an authorized official of a municipal fire 20 department or volunteer fire company, or (6) an advanced emergency medical technician, as defined in section 20-206jj, an emergency 21 medical responder, as defined in section 20-206jj, an emergency 22 23 medical technician, as defined in section 20-206jj, a paramedic, as defined in section 20-206jj, or an authorized official of an emergency 24 25 medical service organization licensed or certified pursuant to chapter 26 368d.
