## AN ACT CONCERNING TRAINING FOR FIREFIGHTERS AND EMERGENCY SERVICES MEDICAL PERSONNEL REGARDING JUVENILES WITH AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER OR NONVERBAL LEARNING DISORDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2020*) On and after January 1, 2020, each initial, review or refresher training program for firefighters

3 of a municipal, state or volunteer fire department or emergency

4 medical services personnel, as defined in section 20-206jj of the general

5 statutes, shall include a course on techniques for handling incidents,

such as wandering, that involve juveniles with autism spectrum

disorder or nonverbal learning disorder if the curriculum for such

8 techniques is made available at no cost to the training provider from

(1) institutions of higher education, health care professionals or

10 advocacy organizations that are concerned with juveniles with autism

11 spectrum disorder or nonverbal learning disorder, or (2) a

12 collaboration of such institutions, professionals or organizations.

To require training for firefighters and emergency services medical personnel on techniques for handling incidents involving juveniles with autism spectrum disorder or nonverbal learning disorder, if the curriculum is available at no cost.
