AN ACT CONCERNING SEXUAL HARASSMENT TRAINING IN THE WORKPLACE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That section 46a-54 of the general statutes be amended to provide that if an employee has received the training provided by the commission pursuant to the provisions of subdivision (8) of subsection (a) of section 46a-56 of the general statutes, while employed by a different employer within the two-year period preceding the employee's date of hire, an employer may consider the employee's prior training to satisfy the training requirements of this section.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce duplicative sexual harassment training requirements for certain employees.
