AN ACT CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF OUTDOOR WOOD-BURNING FURNACES ON NONATTAINMENT DAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 22a-174k of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
3 *passage*):

4 (c) (1) On and after June 6, 2014, no person shall burn any material in
5 any outdoor wood-burning furnace other than wood that is not
6 chemically treated.

7 (2) On and after the effective date of this section, no person shall
8 operate an outdoor wood-burning furnace on any day that the state is
9 not in attainment of the applicable federal limit for the presence of ozone
10 in the state's atmosphere.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
