AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR CHILD CARE PROVIDERS UNDER THE STATE EMPLOYEE HEALTH PLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 2 provider, including, but not limited to, any home child care provider, to
- 3 participate in the state employee health plan.
