AN ACT ESTABLISHING A GRANT PROGRAM TO REIMBURSE MUNICIPALITIES FOR COSTS RELATED TO REMOVAL OF PFAS FROM FIRE APPARATUS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Commissioner of
- 2 Emergency Services and Public Protection shall, within available
- resources, administer a grant program to provide a grant-in-aid to any
- 4 municipality approved for such grant-in-aid by the Department of
- 5 Emergency Services and Public Protection, for (1) the costs associated
- 6 with removing foam containing perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl
- 7 substances (PFAS) from fire apparatus, and (2) the cost of cleaning
- 8 agents necessary for such removal. For the purposes of this section,
- 9 "perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances" or "PFAS" has the
- same meaning as provided in section 22a-255h of the general statutes.
- 11 (b) Any municipality may apply for a grant-in-aid pursuant to this
- 12 section to the commissioner on such form and in such manner as
- 13 prescribed by the commissioner, who may further prescribe additional
- 14 technical or procurement requirements as a condition of receiving such
- 15 grant-in-aid.

16 (c) The department shall distribute grants-in-aid pursuant to this section during the fiscal years ending June 30, 2024, and June 30, 2025.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
