**AN ACT PREVENTING DELIVERY RATE INCREASES AND
DIRECTING A STUDY ON INCREASED COMPETITION IN THE
ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION MARKET.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 277 of the general statutes be amended to prevent
- 2 electric distribution companies from increasing delivery rates such
- 3 companies charge to customers until May 1, 2022, and to direct the
- 4 Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to study whether increased
- 5 competition in the electric distribution market would better serve the
- 6 public interest.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent delivery rate increases until May 1, 2022, and to study whether increased competition in the electric distribution market would benefit the public.
