**AN ACT EXPANDING THE AGE OF ELIGIBILITY FOR SPECIAL  
EDUCATION FOR A CHILD EXPERIENCING DEVELOPMENTAL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-76a of the general statutes be amended to expand the
- 2 age limit for eligibility for special education for a child experiencing
- 3 developmental delay from age five to age nine.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To expand the age limit for eligibility for special education for a child  
experiencing developmental delay from age five to age nine.
