## AN ACT CONCERNING VESSELS, VEHICLES AND IN-STATE TRANSPORTER'S PERMITS FOR ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 30-19f of the general statutes is
- 2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (Effective from
- 3 passage):
- 4 (a) An in-state transporter's permit for alcoholic liquor shall allow the
- 5 commercial transportation of any alcoholic liquor and, with the
- 6 approval of the department, the consumption of alcoholic liquor on a
- 7 <u>vessel or vehicle</u> as permitted by law. The annual fee for an in-state
- 8 transporter's liquor permit shall be one thousand two hundred fifty
- 9 dollars.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
