**AN ACT CONCERNING VESSELS, VEHICLES AND IN-STATE
TRANSPORTER'S PERMITS FOR ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 30-19f of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
3 *passage*):

4 (a) An in-state transporter's permit for alcoholic liquor shall allow the
5 commercial transportation of any alcoholic liquor and, with the
6 approval of the department, the consumption of alcoholic liquor on a
7 vessel or vehicle as permitted by law. The annual fee for an in-state
8 transporter's liquor permit shall be one thousand two hundred fifty
9 dollars.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:
