## AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PLAN FOR THE LICENSURE OF DANCE/MOVEMENT THERAPISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Public Health
- 2 shall develop a plan for the licensure of dance/movement therapists.
- 3 Such plan shall include, but need not be limited to, a description of (1)
- 4 appropriate qualifications, (2) application procedures and fees, (3)
- 5 license renewal procedures and fees, and (4) any disciplinary penalties
- 6 or procedures required for licensure of dance/movement therapists.
- 7 Not later than January 1, 2025, the commissioner shall report such plan,
- 8 in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
- 9 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 10 cognizance of matters relating to public health.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
