AN ACT CONCERNING TRAINING FOR JUDGES AND PROSECUTORS CONCERNING COERCIVE CONTROL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require training for judges
- 2 and prosecutors, instructing them on how to recognize and respond to
- 3 incidents of coercive control in cases involving domestic violence and
- 4 family violence.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the recognition of coercive control for improved safety within families.
