AN ACT EXTENDING THE HOURS DURING WHICH CERTAIN LIQUOR PERMITTEES MAY SELL ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 545 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 cafe, club, restaurant and tavern permittees may sell alcoholic liquor for
- 3 on-premises consumption between: (1) Nine o'clock a.m. and two
- 4 o'clock a.m. on Monday through Thursday; (2) nine o'clock a.m. and
- 5 three o'clock a.m. on Friday and Saturday; and (3) eleven o'clock a.m.
- 6 and one o'clock a.m. on Sunday.

Statement of Purpose:

To extend the hours during which certain liquor permittees may sell alcoholic liquor for on-premises consumption.
