AN ACT CONCERNING EXPERIENCE RATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
2 section 31-225a of the general statutes, the Workers' Compensation
3 Commission shall study the effects on certain businesses that had their
4 experience rate increase. Not later than January 1, 2023, the Workers'
5 Compensation Commission shall report, in accordance with the
6 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
7 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
8 relating to labor regarding the findings of such study.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
