## AN ACT CONCERNING UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION EXPERIENCE RATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) Notwithstanding the provisions of
- 2 section 31-225a of the general statutes, the Labor Department shall study
- 3 the effects on certain businesses that had their experience rate increase
- 4 despite the passage of public act 21-5. Not later than January 1, 2023, the
- 5 Labor Department shall report, in accordance with the provisions of
- 6 section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of
- 7 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor
- 8 regarding the findings of such study. Such report shall include any
- 9 employer that had such rate increased, how many people were
- impacted and the cost to both the state and the employer.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
