



**Substitute House Bill No. 5442**

**Special Act No. 22-13**

**AN ACT CONCERNING UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION EXPERIENCE RATES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 31-225a of the general statutes, the Labor Department shall study the effects on certain businesses that had their experience rate increase despite the passage of public act 21-5. Not later than January 1, 2023, the Labor Department shall report, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor regarding the findings of such study. Such report shall include any employer that had such rate increased, how many people were impacted and the cost to both the state and the employer.
