AN ACT CONCERNING VICTIMS OF CRIME.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) Dedicate additional 2 funding to the victim's compensation fund and expand fund eligibility 3 to victims of crimes committed by juveniles, of motor vehicle theft and 4 other similar property crimes; (2) allow the court in a juvenile matter to 5 order restitution in motor vehicle theft cases; (3) increase funding for the 6 Office of the Victim Advocate; and (4) require the Judicial Branch to 7 study and, if found feasible, implement victim impact panels in juvenile 8 delinquency proceedings.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure victims of crime are appropriately compensated for loss, as well as able to fully participate in the criminal process of the offender.
