AN ACT CONCERNING FREE BUS PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 242 of the general statutes be amended to exempt any
- 2 student enrolled in high school from payment of the lawful charge for
- 3 state-owned or state-controlled bus public transportation during the
- 4 two-hour period before the start of the regular school day and the four-
- 5 hour period immediately following the end of the regular school day.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide free bus public transportation for high school students before and after the regular school day in order for students to access extracurricular activities and employment opportunities.
