AN ACT CONCERNING EMERGENCY INTERVENTION BY A POLICE OFFICER WHEN A PERSON IS EXPERIENCING A NARCOTICS OVERDOSE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17a-683 of the general statutes be amended to allow a
- 2 police officer to take a person into protective custody when the officer
- 3 has reasonable cause to believe that such person is experiencing a
- 4 narcotics overdose.

Statement of Purpose:

To address the opioid epidemic by allowing victims an increased opportunity for medical care and intervention at a treatment facility or hospital.
