## AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES FOR CERTAIN RETIREES UPON SUBSEQUENT EMPLOYMENT BY A BOARD OF EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-438 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 if a uniformed member of a paid municipal fire department or a regular
- 3 member of a paid municipal police department is retired and
- 4 subsequently accepts employment of a public safety nature from certain
- 5 school districts or regional school districts participating in a certain
- 6 municipal employees' retirement system, he or she shall continue to
- 7 receive his or her retirement allowance while so subsequently
- B employed, but he or she shall not be eligible to further participate or be
- 9 entitled to additional credit in such municipal employees' retirement
- 10 system for the period of such subsequent employment.

## Statement of Purpose:

To permit retired public safety personnel to receive retirement allowances, but not credit in a municipal pension system, if such personnel are employed by a local or regional board of education in a public safety capacity after retirement.
