AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES FOR CERTAIN RETIREES UPON SUBSEQUENT EMPLOYMENT BY A BOARD OF EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 7-438 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
2 if a uniformed member of a paid municipal fire department or a regular
3 member of a paid municipal police department is retired and
4 subsequently accepts employment of a public safety nature from certain
5 school districts or regional school districts participating in a certain
6 municipal employees' retirement system, he or she shall continue to
7 receive his or her retirement allowance while so subsequently
8 employed, but he or she shall not be eligible to further participate or be
9 entitled to additional credit in such municipal employees' retirement
10 system for the period of such subsequent employment.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit retired public safety personnel to receive retirement allowances, but not credit in a municipal pension system, if such personnel are employed by a local or regional board of education in a public safety capacity after retirement.
