AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROTECTION OF OLD-GROWTH AND MATURE FORESTS IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to: (1) Add mature and old-2 growth forests as priority areas for acquisition by the Natural Area 3 Preserves System and to expressly bring the definition, identification, 4 and management of mature and old-growth forests under the purview 5 of the Natural Heritage, Open Space and Watershed Land Acquisition 6 Review Board, (2) require that by February 15, 2024, such board shall 7 submit a report to the General Assembly detailing the board's plan to 8 define, identify, and complete an inventory of old-growth and mature 9 forests, and to analyze any threats to mature and old-growth forests in 10 the state, and (3) require that annually thereafter the board shall submit 11 a written report to the General Assembly on or before February 15, 2024, 12 detailing the board's efforts and progress on such plan and including 13 recommendations for the development of policies for conservation 14 strategies for the management and the maximization of protection of 15 mature and old-growth forests and associated rare natural resources.

Statement of Purpose:

To identify, plan for, and manage and protect, old-growth and mature forests, and to provide a mechanism for ongoing reporting to and informing the General Assembly on the status of old-growth forests in the state.
