AN ACT CONCERNING THE REMOVAL OF SERVICE CABLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 283 of the general statutes be amended to require that a 2 cable or telecommunications company remove its service cables from a 3 customer's property not later than thirty days after the customer 4 terminates service with such company and, if a cable or 5 telecommunications company fails to remove such cables within the 6 thirty-day period, to authorize a municipality to fine the company ten 7 dollars for every day after such period that the cables are not removed.

Statement of Purpose:

To: (1) Require cable and telecommunications companies to remove service cables from customers' property not later than thirty days after termination of service; and (2) authorize municipalities to levy fines of ten dollars per day for every day after the thirty-day period until removed.
