AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT TO STUDY PYRRHOTITE AND CRUMBLING CONCRETE FOUNDATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the sum of one million dollars be appropriated to The
- 2 University of Connecticut, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year
- 3 ending June 30, 2020, for the purpose of studying pyrrhotite and the
- 4 issue of crumbling concrete foundations to (1) better understand the
- 5 problem, and (2) identify ways to help homeowners in the state
- 6 impacted by the problem.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to The University of Connecticut for the study of pyrrhotite and the issue of crumbling concrete foundations.
