AN ACT INCREASING FUNDING AND IMPROVING SERVICES FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- That section 10-76g of the general statutes be amended to (1) phase in
- 2 a significantly funded excess cost grant, (2) ensure that a school district
- 3 in which more than ten per cent of its total student population is
- 4 receiving special education or related services receives the full amount
- 5 of its excess costs above four and one-half times its net current
- 6 expenditures per pupil, (3) ensure that excess costs are paid in a more
- 7 timely manner, (4) support an incentive system for students to be
- 8 educated in the town, in the region and in the state, (5) improve the
- 9 identification rates of students who require special education, and (6)
- 10 assist in developing or improving closer-to-home programs coupled
- 11 with ensuring accountability for private placements and facilities.

Statement of Purpose:

To improve funding and services for special education for students.

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
